- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Higgins at 6:00 P.M.
- 2. Roll call was answered by Steve Gast, Sue Philpott, Joel Westendorf, and Doug Miller. Visitors: Scott Johnson & Cory Sievers
- 3. A motion to move 7 after Citizen's Forum of the agenda was made by Miller. Westendorf seconded. 4 ayes.
- 4. Citizen's Forum None present
- 5. <u>Discussion and Action on Skid Loader/Tractor</u> Cory Sievers was present to discuss the lease of a skid loader and the trade in of the John Deere Tractor. The council will ask Tony to track the percentages it would be used in the various departments so it could be decided how it would be billed. Gast moved to defer the lease of a skid loader to next year's budget. Philpott seconded. 4 ayes.
- 6. <u>Discussion and Action on Alcohol License for Mom's</u> This license would be for the truck pull area. Gast moved to change the address to 21 2nd St. Miller seconded. 3 ayes, 1 nay- Westendorf.
- 7. <u>Discussion and Action on Nuisances and Procedures</u> Safe Building procedures were discussed. It was discussed to divide the town into 6 areas with a council member and mayor looking into the nuisances. These would then be given to another council member to have a seconded opinion. Ordinances need to be reviewed. It was decided to hold a workshop on June 18th to discuss ordinances and what would be considered a nuisance.

The day after Thanksgiving and Christmas Eve were added to the holidays for the employees. Dale will write up the changes and present them back to the council for further review.
