- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Higgins at 6:00 P.M.
- 2. Roll Call: Steve Gast, Sue Philpott, Doug Miller, and Ken Jans. Visitors: Sgt. Thompson
- 3. A motion to defer item #5 until party members shows and to approve the agenda was made by Gast. Jans seconded. 4 ayes.
- 4. Citizen's Forum
 - a. Sgt Thompson- Sgt Thompson was present to discuss the sheriff's report and any problems the city had. A new candidate will be sent for training. Discussion on the cars speeding on Main St and the new black marks on Main St. The city needs someone to patrol around 3:00 p.m.
- 5.
